Lights and Flowers and Reflections

Easter is on its way – and although we will still be under certain restrictions, things are looking more promising than even a month ago.

I think it is still unlikely that we will be able to gather for Easter services, as mingling and group interaction will still be risky, but there will be a programme of things we can share in, as we did at Christmas.

Lights

I would like to open the church again so that people can come and light a candle – it's another significant moment in the year when missing loved ones, personal struggles and hurts can rise to the surface, echoed by the Easter story. A candle can be a symbol of hope rising out of the darkness.

Flowers

I am also exploring something outside. I am hoping to put a plain cross up in the churchyard with binding around it, and if you would like to, please bring a cut daffodil or other spring flower over the Easter weekend and transform it into a cross of flowers. It's another reminder, a symbol of emerging hope – that through the pains and sadnesses we have all experienced over the last 12 months, there is hope of a new start, of life in all its beauty and joy.

Reflections

We would normally have little reflections each evening of Holy Week, and on Good Friday, and these will be planned online as we are doing at the moment. All links will be on the church website and Facebook page, and you can always subscribe to the YouTube channel so that you get the link notification.

We may also try and set up something live, but that will depend on what we are allowed to do and what we feel safe doing.

Whatever happens, we will do all we can to walk through the Easter story together.



REPORT

REPORT

Now back to the archives:-

Monthly Meeting held in The Memorial Hall, July 1st 1937.

Mrs W. Jenkins in the Chair.

20 Members present.



23rd December 1925 – 8th November 2020, Remembrance Sunday Our mother born in 1925 and Dad, Horace Worrall born in 1912, were married in 1947 on 27th November. They had four children Sandra, Rosemary, Raymond and Philip. We all lived in Bishops Itchington, in a small cottage opposite the Post Office - it was called The Bank. There were four cottages -two up and one down rooms, toilet outside, it was very cold. We all lived there for a few years. Early years, our Aunt Ruth looked after us sometimes. Then we moved down to Old Road in Bishops Itchington in 1960, but it was very cold as it was November/December we moved there.

Our Dad rented a small holding over the road from Old Road. He had cows, sheep, hens and geese and a gander, so all we had to do was go over the fence and we used to spend our days playing around the farm and go up to the hills and watch the steam trains go by and wave to the drivers. It was many years ago.

Our mother used to work at the chicken farm in Knightcote for a few years with Mrs Hyatt, Mrs Jessie Waring (Taylor) and Minnie Hobday. Mother did some work on Dad's farm for a while, collecting the eggs and feeding the animals, and worked at the mushroom farm down the Gaydon Road in Bishops Itchington. Going back a lot of years, our Josie came across a cutting in a newspaper dated 1952 - our Dad was on his tractor in the village, talking to John Profumo. He was an MP and was very famous not so many years ago, as some of the locals and public would know.

Our mother's mother and father lived down near the cement works in some small cottages - there were only four or five - and then moved up into the village of Bishops Itchington, at the top of the hill, in another row of small cottages where Gran and Gramp Taylor lived for many years.

We all started growing up and went our different ways - like going to school and then working. My mother, when I left school in 1965, took me into Leamington Spa to find a job. There was a choice of George Masons, the grocers, which I took and West's fruit & veg, which was mostly outside and I thought about it, not for me, it would have been too cold. So, after a few years in 1972, I went on a cruise on my own. Dad took me to Leamington train station, went to Southampton to the ship. Was gone two weeks, came back to George Masons and then decided to go to Weymouth to work at Pontins for two years.

Raymond worked at the chicken farm for a few years. Phil worked for Basil Childs. Dad worked later in life for Basil Childs until 1979, until he passed away suddenly on 27th January 1979.

Sister Rosemary left home and went to Kineton. She had Josephine first, her first daughter, then Karen and Ansolena.

Raymond was never married. After Dad passed away, he stayed with my mother at Old Road. Phil got married to Linda, had two children - Amanda and Anthoney. Amanda has a son Jayden, Mum's grandson - he always got a smile from his Nan when he walked in the room. Myself, I got married to Tony on 7th June 1975. We met at Pontins Holiday camp in Weymouth.

Our mother loved going on day trips with senior citizens, playing bingo and all the Christmas dinners and parties with her long-time friend Mrs Fields of Bishops Itchington, who sadly passed away a few years ago. We had a 90th birthday for my mother, she liked a good party. Also, she loved to go to Blackpool for long weekends or for a weeks' holiday. Mum had seven brothers and sisters and she was the last surviving member of the family, so it was a really special time for us.

Mum and Dad looked after Josephine, their granddaughter, who has a daughter Emily and Josie's boyfriend Paul whom mother thought the world of.

Mother was 94 when she passed away peacefully on 8th November 2020, Remembrance Sunday. Josie travelled to Bishops Itchington from Radford Semele in her lunchtimes to feed her Nan and she misses her very much. Myself only visited her a few times to keep her company, as she was in a hospital bed at Old Road being cared for by the family and Linda. Linda was her carer, she did everything for our mother for six months or more and was very good. Also, Amanda helped at the end as mother needed more care. Phil and Anthoney were there keeping an eye on her at night and during the day.

Mother had a lovely funeral on 20th November at Bishops Itchington Cemetery. We had lovely music and the vicar, Reverend B. Clucas, was great. She was buried next to Dad and Ray, reunited with Dad after all these years. Mum's son Raymond passed away 21st June 2015, son-in-law Tony on 11th August 2017 (Sandra's husband) and then suddenly daughter Rosemary on 21st January 2020, so not a very good year really.

We thank my Mother and Dad for the life they gave us and all rest in peace. God Bless. Will be missed by the family.

Vaccination Scam Email. Beware of a scam email entitled 'This is a public health message from NHS'. This scam email claims that the recipient has been selected for a coronavirus vaccination based upon their family genetics and medical history. The emails contain a link that will take you to a website that asks for financial details to pay for the vaccine. Example scam email:

Phishing Email 'Renewal' Warning. Warwickshire Trading Standards has seen several scam 'renewal' emails circulating recently. The bogus emails carry the names of genuine businesses or Government organisations. They usually claim that a payment has failed because there is not enough money in your bank account, or your payment card has expired. The scam emails contain links that direct you to bogus websites where you are asked to login in/enter personal and financial information. This is then stolen and used to commit fraud and identity theft. These bogus websites may also contain malware that could pose a threat to your computer.

Recent scam 'renewal' emails have used the names of these genuine businesses/organisations:

- DVLA (Car tax renewal)
- Netflix
- EE
- TV Licensing
- 02

Never visit a website or log in to an account by following a link in an email. Always type the genuine website address into your browser. Delete all suspicious emails. Don't download any attachments they contain - this might be malware.

Bogus Seller Warning. The pandemic has seen an increase in consumers buying goods and services online. Warwickshire Trading Standards has received a number of complaints from Warwickshire consumers who purchased goods via social media platforms or little-known websites, only to find that the seller was bogus. Money was taken but either no goods were delivered, or the products were fake.

Protect Yourself

- Do your own online research. How long has this business/website/social media profile been in existence? What are other people saying about the seller? Can you verify where the seller is located? Is there any other way of contacting them, other than via an email address or social media?
- If you are buying via a website, make sure it is secure before you place your order. Check their returns policy.
- Pay using a credit card. For products costing more than £100 and below £30,000 you have added protection if things go wrong, and your goods are not delivered. Alternatively, online services like PayPal mean scammers will not be able to get hold of your bank details.
- Don't pay by bank transfer. Fraudsters will often press buyers to pay by bank transfer, but if you get scammed, you don't have the protections afforded to you if you paid using a bank card or via a service such as PayPal.

Blue Badge Copycat Websites. Warwickshire Trading Standards have been made aware of Blue Badge copycat websites. Copycat scams often involve unscrupulous people setting up websites which closely mimic Government or other official sites and charge people a fee to use them, even though the service they are offering is often free of charge. These websites may appear above the genuine website in a web search.

Scam Cavity Wall Upgrade

Warwickshire residents have reported receiving unexpected phone calls from traders, claiming that their cavity wall insulation has degraded and will require upgrading. The callers usually offer free surveys. Residents who initially agree to a survey and then later change their minds have reported not being able to contact the trader.

You can't tell a good trader from a bad one on the doorstep or over the phone. Trading Standards advises that you should never agree to purchase goods or services from cold callers.

National Insurance Number Scam

Several Warwickshire residents have reported receiving bogus phone calls relating to National Insurance (NI) Numbers. The calls range from being told that their NI number has been 'compromised' to being informed that their NI number has been used in a 'suspicious' way and must now be cancelled.

Action Fraud has reported receiving over 1000 reports of NI related scam phone calls. The scammers may be attempting to obtain personal and financial information on the pretence of arranging the delivery of a new NI card. Do not reveal any personal or financial information to cold callers. Always put the phone down.

Appliance Insurance Scam

If you insure your household appliances annually against breakdown, then beware of a scam that is currently circulating. Fraudsters are cold calling Warwickshire residents claiming to be well known insurers and stating either that the appliance cover has lapsed or that it would be cheaper to make a one-off payment than to pay monthly. The fraudsters then take the payments over the phone before disappearing with the money.

Never buy goods or services from cold callers.



Bogus Investment Opportunities

Fraudsters are emailing and cold calling Warwickshire residents claiming to be established and well-known investment companies. The fraudsters then offer the opportunity to invest in a bond before disappearing with the money. The Financial Conduct Authority recently issued a warning about cloned investment firms. Local Council Repairs Cold Calls

Warwickshire residents have reported receiving unexpected phone calls from individuals claiming to be from the 'local council housing repairs department'. These bogus callers appear to want to arrange home repairs to council properties. These phone calls are not being made by genuine councils. Residents are urged to put the phone down.


