There was a good turnout for our February meeting, the numbers including three new faces. Hopefully we gave them a warm welcome and we look forward to seeing them at future meetings and events. Between them Val, President; Jane, Secretary; and Sandra, Treasurer, rattled through the business items. We do take the business seriously. Honestly, we do; but we don't want to spend the whole evening on it. And we have to tailor the meeting to some extent to the needs of our members and get a balance to please everyone (is that possible?). We handed in our votes on this year's proposed resolutions, the most popular, nationally will be further debated at the National AGM in Liverpool in the summer before taking action on it, including lobbying the government. Barbara P gave progress on her project in which many of our members are involved. All will be revealed, in public, at the beginning of June.

Our speaker was Bob Clucas, a former vicar of this parish. His talk, entitled "Weeds or Wildflowers?" was based on his experiences of stocking his own large garden over many years. He explained that he's not an expert or a professional gardener but is what he calls a generalist, i.e. "Someone who knows almost nothing about almost everything". He also said that he's not a perfectionist and is happy with "Not bad". Illustrated with a video and slides we saw views of his informal and attractive garden containing lots of wildflowers, many of which some people would consider weeds. As a very enthusiastic amateur his knowledge of wildflowers is immense. And he admitted that there are some plants that even he ousts from his garden – because of course, they're in the wrong place. He also answered our questions and gave recommendations of which wildflower gardening books to obtain. It was a lovely relaxed talk which we all enjoyed. So thanks very much Bob, that was not at all bad!



After the huge spread of refreshments had been enjoyed we had brief instructions on making tissue paper flowers, then armed with a pipe cleaner, a piece of cotton thread and several pieces of tissue paper we set to and made our own. Such fun! Actually they didn't look bad.

We've welcomed new players to our Walking Netball sessions. This sport is for any age and ability – the whole idea being that even if not very agile you can still take part. Most of each session is taken up with exercises (usually requiring a more agile mind than body!) which are great fun. You don't need to be a WI member to join. So if you want to have a laugh and keep fit at the same time, ladies, why not join us on Wednesdays 10am in the Playing Field tennis courts. ## **A WALK AROUND THE CEMETERY : HARRIET DODD**

On entering the cemetery, walk to the potting shed and there, on the right-hand side, four graves from the Spinney is the last resting place for Harriet Dodd. For some reason she was buried in un-consecrated ground, I do not know why, she was baptized, married in Church and died of natural causes. Perhaps over the years Harriet became a non-conformist.

Harriet was born in Avon Dassett, she was baptized at Avon Dassett Church on 25<sup>th</sup> September 1831. Her parents were John Barnes (born 1801) and Ann Barnes nee Baldwin (1801) Harriet's sibling were Elizabeth (1826), Mary (1827), William (1829), Caroline (1834) and John (1840). The Barnes family all lived in Avon Dassett, you can trace members of the family to 18c, all living at Avon Dassett.

By the time Harriet was 20 years old she was working as a house servant at Ratley Oxfordshire. The house held 9 servants, Harriet would have taken her orders from the Housekeeper and she would have done the washing of clothes and dishes, all by hand, no machines like we use today. Also, lighting the house fires each morning, changing bed linen etc. Harriet would have lived in the house, most likely had the top part of the house and she would also have been given a uniform to wear, plus limited amount of cash and one afternoon per week to use as she liked. All prepared the servants for married life.

Harriet married John Dodd of Bishops Itchington, they married on 25<sup>th</sup> November 1851 at Avon Dassett Church, moving to live at Bishops Itchington. The children of the marriage were all born in the village, Annice (1853), Catherine (1858), Harriet (1861), John (1868), Richard (1870) and Ruth (1875).

## **A WALK AROUND THE CEMETERY : HARRIET DODD**

Harriet lost her son Richard in 1898, he had been married for 6 years and had a daughter aged 1 years. This must have been a great shock to Harriet owing to her elder son, John, moving to live in West Ham Essex and her daughter Ruth living with her husband Joseph Reading in Hemsworth Yorkshire. Harriet must have felt as if her family were slipping away as to travel to West Ham or Hemsworth would be a good day's journey for an elderly lady to travel.

Harriet was a very good dressmaker, most families made their own clothes, but she was well known for smocking stitch which is a delicate stitch used for wedding dresses and christening clothes. She did make her own wedding dress plus, when her daughters married, she made all the wedding outfits, remember all was done by hand.

As the children of the marriage left home, Catherine and Harriet stayed within the village. Catherine married a farmer, John Lea, he farmed Model Farm which is just past the railway bridge down Ladbroke Road. Harriet married Benjamin Clark who was born in Welton, Northamptonshire (they settled in Lower End). Annice married John Berry from a village family, they moved within walking distance of the village settling in Ladbroke. Richard and John travelled to settle in West Ham Essex with their families, Ruth was in Yorkshire.

As Harriet and John got older they decided to move and live at Model Farm with Catherine and her husband, John Lea. They had three children plus a servant Thomas Ali Worrall whose family were well known in the village.

Harriet was buried on 31<sup>st</sup> December 1906, followed by her husband John on 29<sup>th</sup> March 1911. Descendants of Harriet still live in the area.

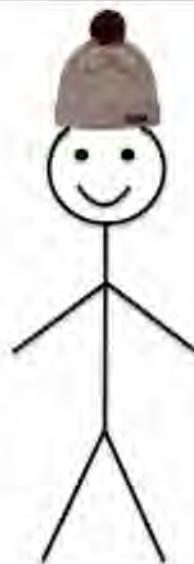
